INTRO: [Any military members? War vets? Family stories? We are all in a war, like it or not. ON BOARD: Cultural war, Moral war, Spiritual war. Growing up, it was in the background; now in the open][Psalm 94:16 – The king asking for God's help – In a real sense, God is asking for our help]

- III. Our Reaction to Evil
 - A. Measure it Genesis 6:5-7; 18:20,21; Psalm 7:11; 11:5; Isaiah 30:18,27,30; Nahum 1:3,6; Mark 3:5; John 2:13-17; Revelation 6:16,17[How?] [By looking at God's hatred for it][Gen. 6:5-7; Left to itself, evil always degenerates into more evil] [The Lord Jesus - Mark 3:5; John 2:13-17; Rev. 6:16,17]
 - B. Hate it [Tell me of a man who is never angry, that man has not any true zeal for God. We must sometimes be angry against sin. When we see evil, though not vindictive against the persons who commit it, yet angry against the evil we must be; we must hate wickedness always. - Spurgeon]

 - C. Mortify it Romans 8:13; Colossians 3:5-10
 - D. Expose it Ephesians 5:11-13 [We are called <u>by</u> God to speak <u>for</u> God] Psalm 94:6; Salt and light, Matthew 5:14 [There is nothing else that can put evil away so quickly as the proclamation of right. Help the minister of the Gospel; pray for him; hold up his hands; endeavor to strengthen him. Spurgeon]
 - 1. Examples of evil
 - a. False gospels Psalm 119:104; Jeremiah 44:4,5; Revelation 2:6: Galatians 1:8 [there is a "deeply rooted hostility in our soul against the Word" – Sproul] [our fallen nature struggles against it]
 - b. Evolution Genesis 1
 - c. Sexual sin Mark 6:18 [Including sex trafficking, adultery, fornication, homosexuality]

- d. Abortion Jeremiah 7:31; Psalm 139:13 [New York state's new law – "It's another barrier-breaking day in New York" –State Senate Majority Leader – "protect life and <u>health"</u> after 24 weeks – not physician only – Also, Virginia Governor's post birth view]
- e. Fake news, false witness Psalm 119:104 [Again]
- f. Injustice Leviticus 19:15; Proverbs 11:1 ["So far as a man loves God, he must hate everything that is contrary to God." – Jonathan Edwards]
- g. Idolatry Ephesians 5:5,6 [Greed]
- h. The Apostle's list Galatians 5:19-21
- i. Others? [Drugs]
